Don't forget, everyone is welcome to join them.

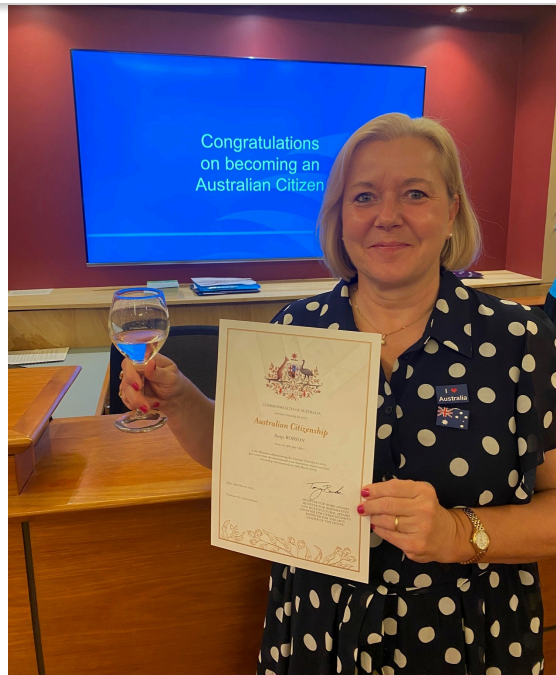
