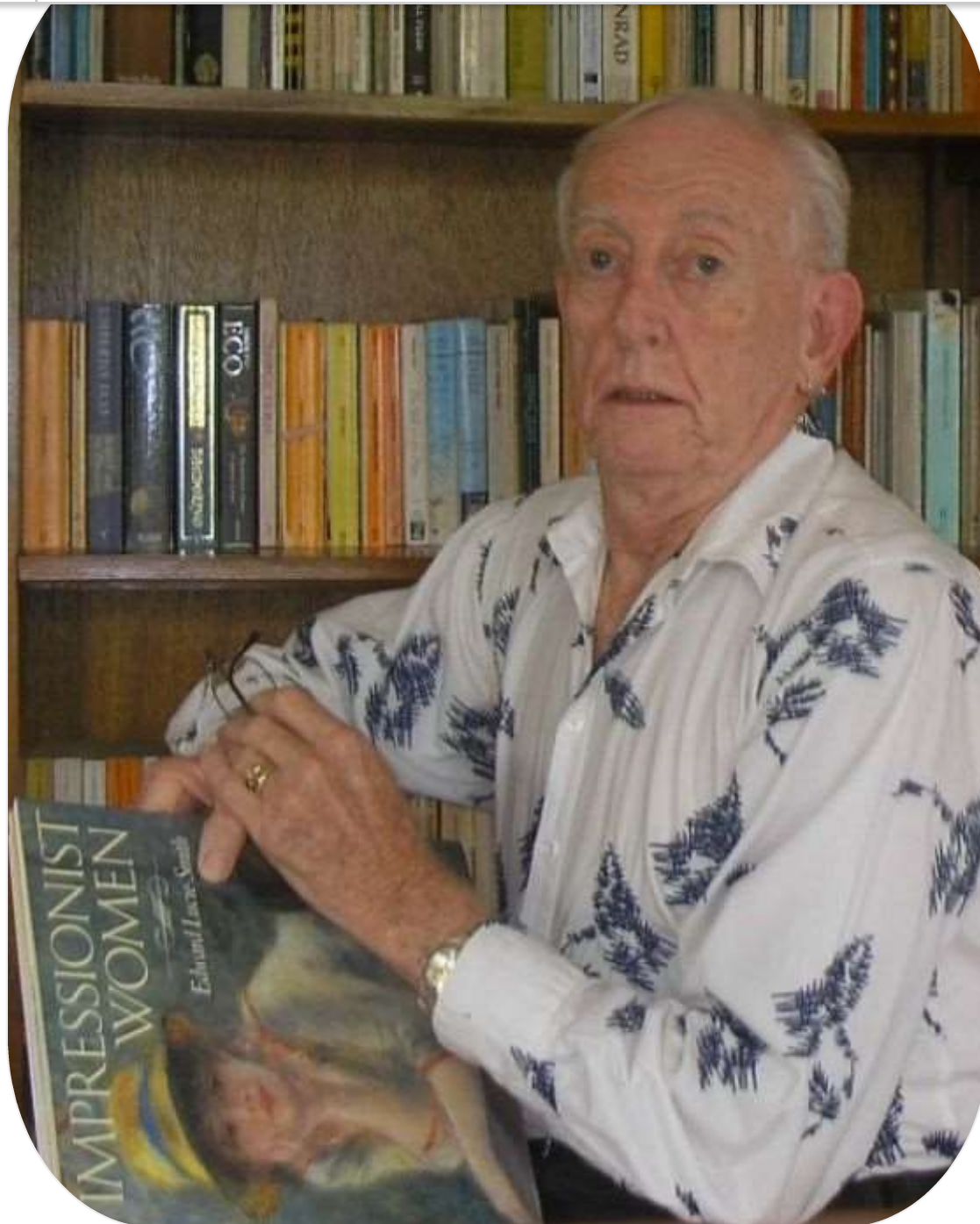

Thursday August 10th**



Carl Altmann, MA, a very engaging and popular art history lecturer and artist at UWA's Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery (LWAG), will regale us with some little-known facts about some of Australia's famous artists, whose works are on display at LWAG. Carl will give us some insights into the artists' lives, as well as the various elements and principles of art that can help us delve more deeply into the meaning of individual pieces. Carl has devoted over 20 years to teaching art and art history to all ages, from his work with gifted children through the Education Department to adults at the Mature Adults Learning Association and the Friends of Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery at UWA. His love of art and his abiding belief that art can be accessible to everyone are evident in all the ways he encourages artists and art lovers, whether through his own artwork, which has been exhibited nationally and internationally, his workshops, speaking engagements, museum tours or his frequent presence as a judge for such competitions as the Black Swan Art Prize and the Collie Art Prize. Carl and his wife, Jan, who is also a well-respected artist and art historian, will join us for the August PWP luncheon, and they will no doubt remind us why we all love art and inspire us to seek it out at Lawrence Wilson Art Gallery and beyond.

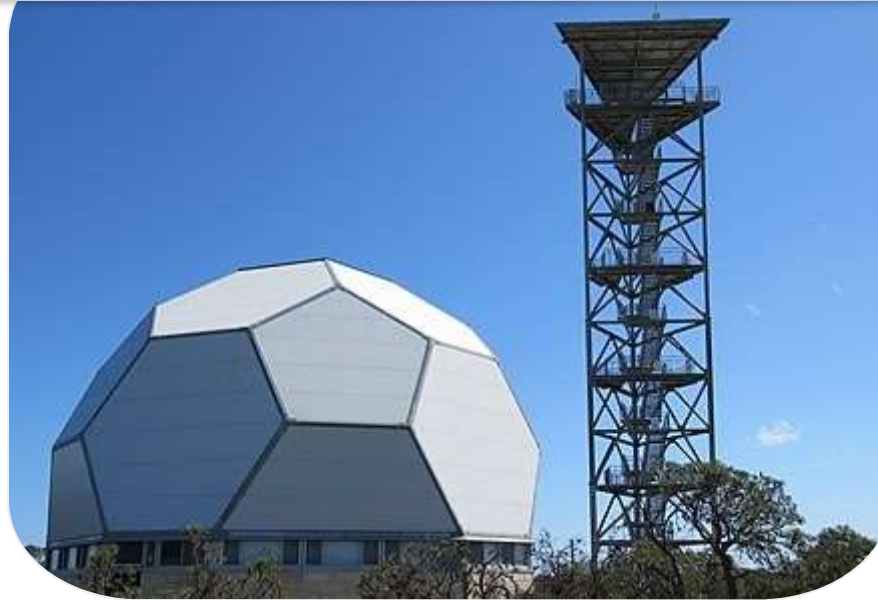
