☐ Sunshine and Silver Linings ☐

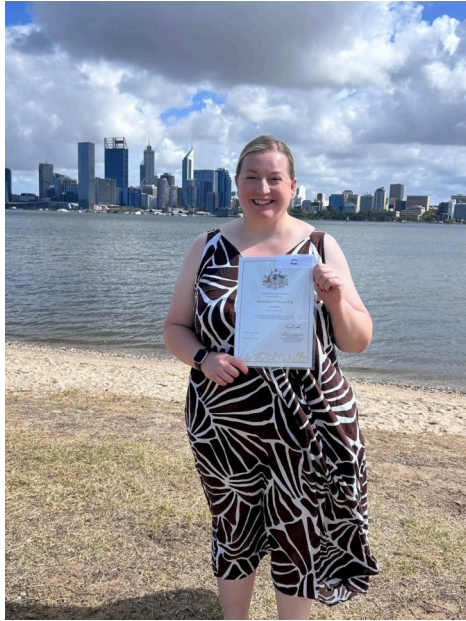

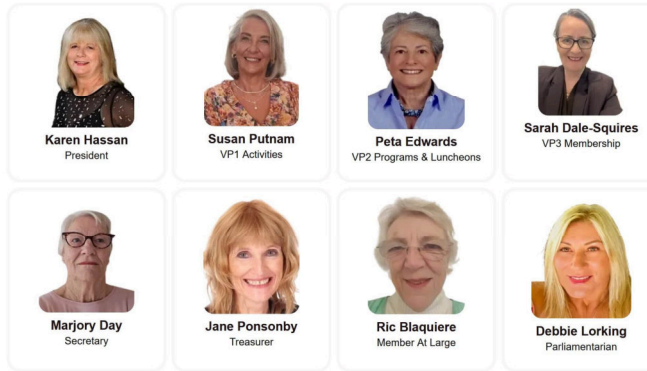
