The Trust was established in 1965 following the death of Sir Winston Churchill, with the principal objective of perpetuating and honouring his memory by the awarding of Memorial Fellowships, known as 'Churchill Fellowships'. The aim of the Trust is to provide an opportunity for Australians to travel overseas to conduct research in their chosen field. It also aims to reward individuals who possess passion and a commitment to make a difference in Australian society. Since 1965 over 4500 Fellowships have been awarded. Cheryle will talk about the Trust and its objectives, and share the stories and experiences of some of the recipients. Prior to her retirement Cheryle was an experienced nursing executive with senior positions in the public and private sectors.

We can look forward to hearing how Churchill Fellows learn globally and inspire locally.

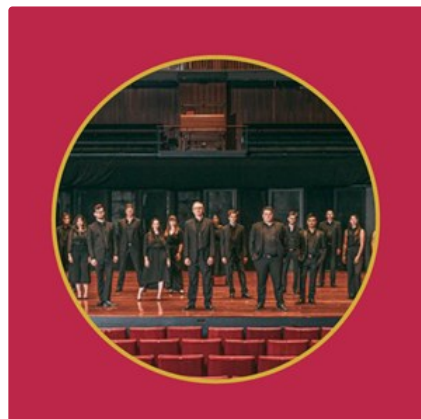

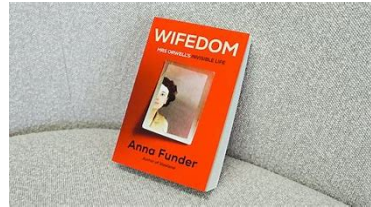
