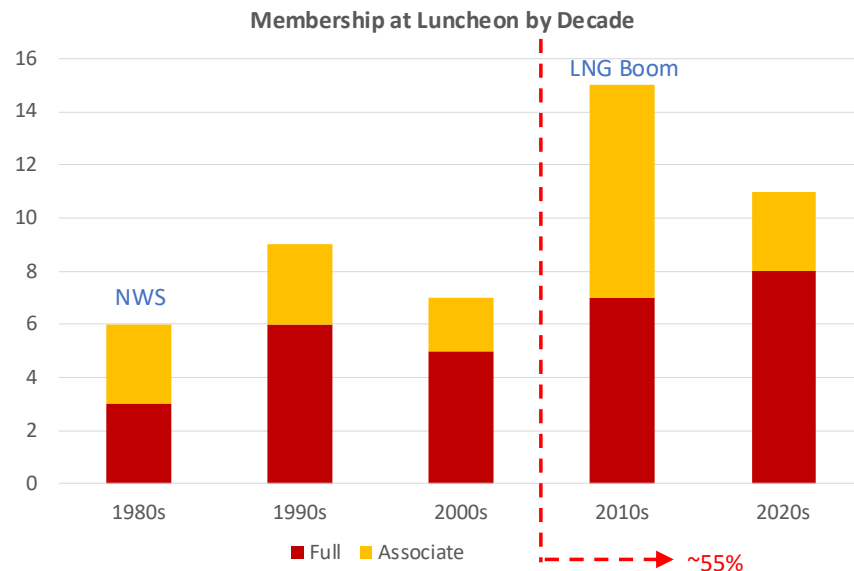

PETROLEUM CORNER by Kari

As I was preparing for the July luncheon, I decided to make a data snapshot of the expected attendees. I wondered about the ratio of Full to Associate Members, as well as long-term members versus newer members. Here is the data snapshot and the story I think it tells.



We had a 60/40 split between Full/Associate members. About 1/3 of Full members were in attendance, and about 2/3 of Associate members were present. I wondered if that varied by decade of joining. The above graphic shows that about 45% of attendees joined between 1979 and 2010, while 55% joined the club in the last 12 years (including the 2+ Covid pandemic years). All of the numbers make sense in terms of what was happening in our industry. The Northwest Shelf had just opened up in the late 70's, so we would have had a big boom in membership around then, which continued as the projects are still going on today. A second boom would have started with a lot of LNG projects starting up around 2009. You can see that over half of the 2010's attendees are Associates. That also makes sense, because the Full members who were expats were sent home in large numbers at the start of the pandemic in 2020, leaving more Associates to represent that decade.

Of course, this data is a snapshot of only one luncheon. I did the same calculations for the entire membership (Full/Associate and joining dates by decade) and the curve looked very similar. If we were to dig into the same type of data for all of our events, luncheons, and hobby groups, I think we could likely use that data to inform our membership recruiting efforts. It can also guide us to make good decisions about some changes we might make to strengthen our recruiting, member retention, and leadership selection. The rules we currently have in place, combined with the very small number of prospective members from the petroleum industry entering the country post-Covid, make it increasingly difficult to recruit and retain members and leaders, especially in terms of Board eligibility. In order to see which changes seem most appealing to the members, luncheon attendees were asked to complete a quick survey. I will present the results of the survey and a list of committee members who will be tasked with further evaluation of the proposals at the August luncheon. If you would like to submit a survey for inclusion in those results, please email your completed survey to me at pwp.perthpresident@gmail.com no later than August 1st.
